



WORLD ORAL HEALTH DAY

To commemorate World Oral Health Day, the Department of Public Health Dentistry visited Maratha Mandal's PU College, Maratha Mandal's Polytechnic College, and Maratha Mandal's High School, Honaga. At each of the three places, health talk was given related to their oral health issues, caries, and maintenance of oral hygiene. A tooth brushing technique was also demonstrated. FDI's campaign theme posters, banners, and fact sheets were used to raise awareness regarding oral health. An oral screening of staff and students was undertaken at Maratha Mandal's High School.

Awareness regarding the FDI World Dental Federation's overarching campaign theme "Be Proud of Your Mouth" was done with the help of handmade campaign frames. This course entailed didactic lectures, hands-on training, and case discussions. A senior periodontist and implantologist from Mumbai, Dr. Nrupal Kothare, was the course coordinator. Dr. Kothare has had vast experience in the field of implantology for the past 30 years, having placed and guided more than 10,000 dental implants. The staff of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery headed by Dr. Ranganath Nayak, Periodontology headed by Dr. Aarati Nayak, and Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge headed by Dr. Rajendra Hallikerimath, under the guidance of the Principal, Dr. Ramakant Nayak, guided the postgraduates along with Dr. Nrupal Kothare. The 16 participants in the course received extensive training in treatment planning, implant placement, suturing, and surgical protocol on simulation models. This was followed by a live surgical demonstration. Thirty-one implant surgeries were done under guidance on the last two days of the course by the participants. All the patients were immensely satisfied with the implant surgeries conducted. The implant course was supported by the President of Maratha Mandal, Smt.
