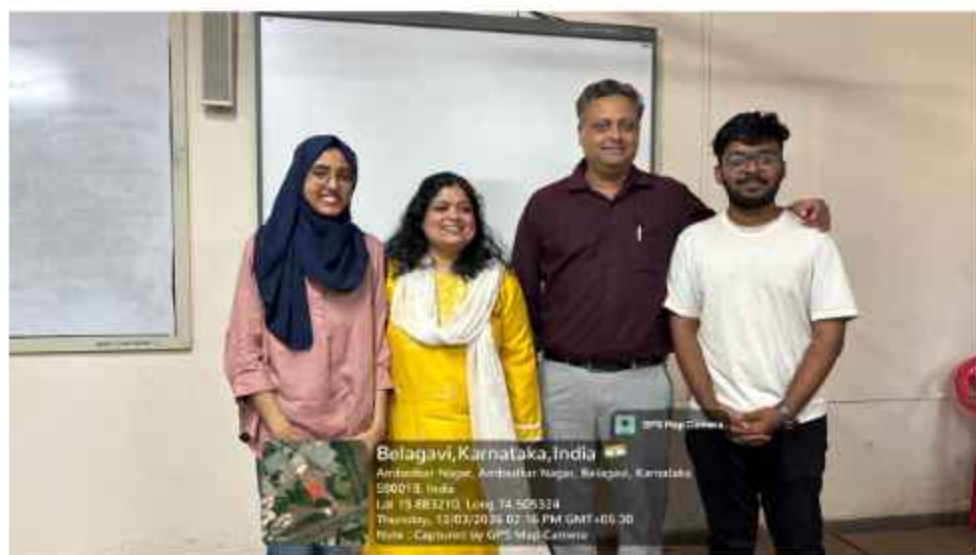
11:30 am -HOOKSTEP HUSTLE
